**AJAS Conference COVID Vaccination Policy**

Nothing is more important than the safety and health of conference attendees, guests and exhibitors and business partners. AJAS believes it has a responsibility to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus, and to protect the safety and wellbeing of all conference participants.

Therefore, AJAS will require that all conference attendees, guests and exhibitors and business partners be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as a condition to attend all conference events.

Individuals are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after their second dose in a two-dose series such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.

To the extent booster shots are recommended by the CDC, FDA or other state or federal authority in the future, this policy shall require that all conference attendees, guests and individuals representing exhibitors and business partners receive all recommended booster shots to be deemed fully vaccinated.

All attendees must provide proof of vaccination to AJAS prior to attendance. Specific details on software to gather this information to follow.
